Thu, Mar 21, 2019	2.9%	207
Fri, Mar 22, 2019	10.5%	219



CONCLUSIONS

For the period of this monitoring:

1.	The posted speed limit is 25 MPH
2.	Tuesday was the heaviest traffic day
3.	Friday was the fastest traffic day
4.	Over the 4-day period, 95% of vehicle speeds were 25 MPH or less
5.	Over the 4-day period, 5% of vehicle speeds were greater than 25 MPH
6.	Over the 4-day period, 0.9% of vehicle speeds were greater than 30 MPH
7.	Overall, there is little evidence of a speeding problem (Ferndale PD agrees)
